<p>CHART 1: If you have good vision (20/20) you should read to solid line; passable vision (20/30) to shaded line.</p>	<p>CHART 2: Test for astigmatism*. If one or two spikes are sharp and the rest blurred, you are astigmatic.</p>
<p>Astigmatism: A visual defect in which the unequal curvature of one or more refractive surfaces of the eye, usually the cornea, prevents light rays from focusing clearly at one point on the retina, resulting in blurred vision.</p>	
<p>Have your eyes checked every two years</p>
